2019 WKC CANADIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS OVERVIEW

1. **All Kata and Weapons** divisions will consist of 2 rounds. All competitors compete in both rounds with the combined total scores of the 2 rounds deciding the top 4 competitors. Competitors compete in reverse order for the second round. Any drops or falls in weapons or kata will result in a .05 deduction. Therefore if a judge was going to give a 9.97, they would show a 9.92, this way the competitor may still make the top 4 with a strong finish in the second round. Any questions on rules for a specific division should be made before the division starts.
2. **Point sparring** will consist of 2 rounds. Competitors are placed in a random draw and the top eight competitors are determined. Points are then rewarded to the top 8. 1st – 100pts, 2nd-75pts, 3rd-50pts, 4th-25pts, 5th-8th -10 points. In the second round on Sunday, competitors are seeded by their rankings in the first round. (if in your first fight of round 1 you fought the eventual 1st place winner, in round 2 you would fight someone else.)
